

# Contest rules – Euromed

## Trophées scientifiques de Corse 2024



### Article 1 : WHO CAN COMPETE ?

#### 1.1 Conditions of participation

Competition is open to all students aged 11-18 from partner schools.

The teacher in charge of the group signs up to the competition with the agreement of the Head Teacher, by using a valid email adress.

**Maximum number per group : 3 students - 1 accompanying teacher/supervisor**

#### 1.2 Application requirements and Deadlines

All applicants must complete the on-line registration form before **Friday, December 29th, 2023.**

Please note that it is mandatory to register online and to give all the information required (especially the name of the workshop you want to present).

## Article 2 : OBJECTIVES PURSUED

### 2.1 Works you can create

The students can create together a work (e.g. pictures, experiments, practical works, models, exhibitions, comic strips, videos).

You will present your work to the other groups (aged 11 to 18) during the project presentation day held on Friday, April 5th 2024 in Corte (University of Corsica).

The Scientific work must necessarily focus on physics and be presented in English.

Material costs are to be borne by participants (e.g. foam board, models, exhibition panels, posters, experiments, arrangement.)  
Artistic expressions accepted : pencils, pastels, paintings, felt pens, collage.

Works must be transportable, so that they can be presented to the other participants during the presentation day. Transportation costs of the works for the presentation day are to be borne by the group.

### 2.2 Presentation of your work

Each group will have **10 minutes** to present its scientific work to the public and to jury members. There will be a 2 minutes break between each presentation.

**The presentation of the work in front of the jury must be in English.** However, you will have the option to deliver your presentation in a different language to the audience, based on their comprehension.

Please indicate on your group panel the languages you will use to present your work (according to their language skills).

## Exceptional case

The first four countries to register will be offered transport, food and accommodation for the event's duration.

Other teams wishing to participate can either attend on their own or do it via live video conferencing.

## **Article 3 : DEADLINES**

**Friday, December 29<sup>th</sup> 2023:** Deadline for online registration.

**Friday, April 5<sup>th</sup> 2024:** Presentation day of your works and award ceremony

## **Article 4 : ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

The international jury will evaluate each project (the work, the title and the explanation text) based on the following criteria (20 points per each criteria ; a maximum of 100 points) :

- relevance ;
- quality ;
- originality ;
- scientific and educational aspects ;
- collaborative spirit

## **Article 5 : COMPOSITION OF THE JURY**

The works will be submitted to the appreciation of an international jury:

- Teachers / Researchers
- Professionals
- Staff of the Academy of Corsica
- Staff of the Association - A Rinascita

If a jury member is absent, the president may designate a substitute.

The jury's verdict is final and not subject to appeal.

## **Article 6 : PRESENTATION DAY OF WORKS AND AWARDS CEREMONY**

The presentation and award ceremony day will take place on Friday, April 5<sup>th</sup>.

During the presentation day, the works will have to be presented by a group of students while the rest of the class will visit the other works and scientific workshops.

**In order for each class to attend each presentation, your presentation should not exceed 10 minutes.**

## **Article 7 : AWARDS**

Award winners :

### **7.1 The jury prize**

A group from the EUROMED section selected by the jury will be awarded science-related prizes.

No objection to the rewards awarded will be accepted.

Prizes will not be returned or exchanged for cash or any other gift.

The CPIE - A Rinascita association reserves the right to replace the prizes of the same value.

## **Article 8 : PHOTO COPYRIGHT RELEASE AND USE OF DATA**

Teachers and / or group leaders are invited to complete the "image rights" form.

Any participant (teacher, parent or legal representative of the winners) consent and authorize the use by the association CPIE- A Rinascita of photographs, videos and / or voice recordings of the participating students, taken during the awards ceremony. The participants also consent to the use of the images or any reproduction without any financial compensation:

- On the Internet ;
- On any digital support ;
- On any paper support ;
- On screen in any school or cultural event

- use the production, including its distribution in public places (administration hall, showroom ...) and private, in the press, in all magazines and on websites;
- authorize the rights of reproduction, adaptation and representation of the productions for an external communication campaign (poster, postcard ...) for an unlimited duration.

The authors of productions will ensure compliance with the law, including image rights and intellectual property.

NB : By participating to the competition, any participating class or any hypothetical right-holder, authorizes in advance without any financial consideration in return, CPIE - A RINASCITA to use, reproduce and photograph for the purposes of promoting the competition on any communication media. Classes cannot claim copyright in the use of its production (work or name).

## Article 9 : ACCEPTANCE OF THE RULES

By taking part in the competition, the participant accepts unreservedly the present rules and the principle of the competition.

The organizers reserve the right, in particular for compelling reasons and/or for reasons of force majeure, to shorten, extend, suspend, or cancel the present competition in part or in full if circumstances so require. It may not be held liable in such a case.

The parties shall endeavor to seattle any dispute by amicable means.

Any interpretation of the rules of this contest belongs to the jury. No contestation or claim will be admitted. The jury's decision is final.
